COVID-19 Updates

Dear Residents,

Governor Inslee announced a four-week statewide set of restrictions in response to the recent rapid spread of COVID-19 virus in Washington and across the county. In light of these new restrictions and with the holidays upon us, we believe strongly that the time is now to take extra measures in safeguarding your health and well-being.

Effective Monday, November 16 and until further notice, the following are closed:
Beauty salon, fitness center, pool and small group activities.

Lastly, and most importantly, the most prudent thing that we all can do this holiday season is choose not to gather in person. The governor's proclamation includes the **prohibition of indoor social gatherings with people from outside your household**. Therefore, we are pleading with residents, staff, families, and the greater community to be cautious of the risk of exposure to COVID-19 during your outside travels. COVID-19 is opportunistic and will not take the "day off" during the seasonal holidays.

The postponement of any activity or life event is heartbreaking. But while everything may look a little different this year, take heart. We are on this journey together – residents, staff, and families.
