## COVID-19 Update

December 4, 2020

Dear Bayview families,

We find ourselves in the midst of Governor Inslee's announced four-week statewide set of restrictions in response to the recent rapid spread of COVID-19 virus in Washington and across the county. In light of these restrictions and with the holidays upon us, we believe strongly that the time is now to take extra measures in safeguarding resident health and well-being.

In accordance with the Governor's proclamation, effective Tuesday, November 17 and until further notice, indoor visitation for Assisted Living, Memory Care, and Skilled Nursing continue to be prohibited. However, we shifted visitation to an outdoor setting.

Starting Saturday, December 5<sup>th</sup> we will have a 10x10 white tent set up in the Visitor Parking Lot with a heater for outdoor visits. We encourage families to bundle up and dress appropriately during your scheduled visits. Visitors for AL/SNF/MC will be met by staff monitors in the parking lot outside of the tent for a pre-visit assessment. Those residents assessed as a high risk for elopement have a separate white 10x10 tent located on Dorothy's Place for outside visits.   - Tuesday, Wednesday, Saturday and Sunday at 10:15 am, 1:15 pm, 2:15 pm or 3:15 pm.
- **Memory Care (MC) visitation times are:**
  - Monday and Thursday at 10:15 am, 1:15 pm or 2:15 pm.
