COVID-19 Update: Visitors in Public Spaces

Bayview continues to experience no new positive cases and as of 03/16/22, the King County Rates of Infection is 95.4 per 100,000 people. We are pleased to announce the next phase of reopening:

Effective immediately: Public/common spaces will be open for Bayview visitors. This includes but is not limited to:

- 10th floor
- Main Lobby
- Albertson Center/Chapel
- Kinnear Theater
- Library, McKnight Room, Studio
- Terrace Lawn

Source control (facemask) is still required for all common spaces. Visitors are currently not allowed to participate in resident activities or bring food or drinks in these spaces at this time. Dining venues (in each of the respective levels of care) are also currently not open to visitors at this time. Due to staffing shortages in our Culinary Services department, we hope this phase of reopening will occur soon.

As a reminder, our community is open to unrestricted visitation to Independent Living, Assisted Living, Memory Care, and Skilled Nursing & Rehab. Visitation numbers, frequency, duration, and schedules are no longer necessary. **Visitors must always wear a facemask and properly screen at reception.**

We look forward to sharing additional updates regarding relaxation of facemask requirements in our next memo.
