

COVID-19 Update: Update on Positive Cases

Dear residents, staff, families, and the greater community,

As of Monday, May 2, 2022, the Leadership Team became aware of an additional staff who has tested positive. **This brings a total number of five active cases within the building.** Please note that our case count still remains at five since our latest memo on May 1, 2022, as one staff has returned to work safely. The breakdown of cases are as follows.

- 1 Independent Living Resident
- 1 Intergenerational Children's Center Staff Member
- 3 non-clinical Health Center Staff Members
 - In accordance with the King County Department of Health, the Skilled Nursing Unit is considered in an "outbreak" status through Monday, May 30, 2022.
 - Since none of our residents have tested positive in the Health Center, there
 is no change to our visitation policy. Visitors may visit as normal.
