## **COVID-19 Update Re: Active Positive Case Count**

The Leadership Team became aware of **3 new positive cases of COVID-19 as** of Monday, 1/17/22. This brings our total active cases to 13 within the building. Please note the numbers have adjusted and any residents or staff who have been removed from quarantine are not included in the total count.

## Here is the breakdown of cases:

- 8 residents in total have tested positive for COVID-19.
  - $\circ~$  4 of the 8 residents are located on the Health Center.
  - $\circ~$  4 of the 8 residents are located on Independent Living.
- 5 staff members in total have tested positive for COVID-19.
  - 1 of the 5 staff members work in the Intergenerational Children's Center.
  - 4 of the 5 staff members work in non-clinical areas within the community.

The King County rates of infection is 2,161.62 per 100,000 people as of 1/17/21.

The number of positive cases at Bayview continues to decline test after test from Discover Labs. Thank you to residents and staff for your diligence in consistent and frequent testing. We are not out of the woods yet and despite the current community data, each week is looking brighter. In conjunction with the Centers for Disease Control, county, state, and federal health agencies, the Leadership team is actively monitoring and discussing where we stand as it relates to when we are able to safely open up again.
