COVID-19 Updates Re: Additional Positive Cases

The Leadership Team just became aware of **5 new additional positive cases of COVID-19 as of Sunday**, **1/9/22. This brings our total positive cases to 33 within the building.** Here is the breakdown of cases:

- 19 residents in total have tested positive for COVID-19.
 - 14 of the 19 residents are located on the Health Center (Skilled Nursing).
 - \circ 1 of the 19 residents is located on Memory Care.
 - \circ 4 of the 19 residents are located on Independent Living.
- 14 staff members in total have tested positive for COVID-19.
 - \circ 8 of the 14 staff members work on the Health Center.
 - 1 of the 14 staff members work on Assisted Living.
 - 1 of the 14 staff members work in the Intergenerational Children's Center.
 - 4 of the 14 staff members work in non-clinical areas within the community.

The total above reflects all results from Discover Labs from last week, including Thursday, 1/6/22. As we begin a new week, we are calling for renewed commitment in the fight against COVD-19 for all residents and staff. Please utilize our on-site testing on Mondays and Thursdays. Our need for heightened and strict adherence to the core principals of infection control (proper use of facemasks, excellent hand hygiene, etc.) is important now, more than ever.
