COVID-19 Update:

The leadership team became aware of 1 new positive case of COVID-19 as of Wednesday, 2/9/22. **This brings our total count of active positive cases to 4 within the building.** Here is the breakdown of cases:

- 2 residents in total have tested positive for COVID-19.
 - Both residents are located on Independent Living.
- 2 staff members in total have tested positive for COVID-19.
 - Both staff members work in a non-clinical setting (or non-licensed areas).

KING COUNTY RATES OF INFECTION:

1/29/22: 2,065.7 per 100,000 people

1/22/22: 3,024.6 per 100,000 people

1/15/22: 3,675.5 per 100,000 people

For nearly 24 months, we've been focused on King County Rates of Infection and active case count within the building as benchmarks for tightening or loosening restrictions. If the coronavirus is here to stay, the path from pandemic to endemic may be in our near future. Discussions around the leadership table as well as around the world have been revolved around re-examining our COVID-19 strategies and how the pandemic endgame or the start of a new endemic phase would redefine the way we keep both safe and thriving.
