COVID-19 Updates: Intergenerational Children's Center

Dear residents, staff, families, and the greater community,

The Leadership Team became aware of two staff members in our Intergenerational Children's Center who have tested positive for COVID-19 over the weekend. This brings a total of 2 COVID positive cases in the building. Contract tracing and proper steps to mitigate exposure are proactively being taken.

The Children's Center will be closed on Monday (04/18/22) and Tuesday (04/19/22) and reopen on Wednesday (04/19/22). Intergenerational programming between residents and children has been temporarily suspended. We will update you as soon as we determine when it is safe to resume intergenerational activities and events.

With the rise of King County rates of infection, we are holding off rolling back any further restrictions at this time. We will continue to monitor our current status and infection rates over the next few weeks.
