COVID-19 Updates:

Dear residents, staff, families, and the greater community:

As of Wednesday, July 27th, we have a total of two active cases within the building. The current King County Rates of Infection is 564.4 per 100,000 people as of 07/16/22. The breakdown of cases are as follows:

2 residents in Independent Living have tested positive for COVID-19

First and foremost, we are grateful for everyone's support as we cautiously move through phases of reopening to ensure that our efforts are sustainable and efficient while mitigating potential risks. Over the next few weeks, we will continue our progression towards reopening starting with reinstating co-mingling and then with dining.

Effective Monday, August 1st:

 Co-mingling will resume in non-dining settings. i.e. activities and events, fitness center, apartments. Co-mingling is defined as the intermingling of residents between different care levels - Independent Living, Assisted Living, Memory Care, and Health Center.

The next phase of reopening will entail opening our main dining venue to families and visitors with **limited reservations per day**. We are excited at the prospect of once again allowing outside visitors to dine with loved ones. Stay tuned on this front.
