## COVID-19 Update

Dear residents, staff, families, and the greater community,

As of the writing of this memo on Saturday, February 18, 2023, we have **one active case** in our Skilled Nursing and Rehab Center.

### **While visitation is still allowed, we are asking that all visitors consider the following:**

- Visitors should not conduct in-person visits if they have any of the following:
  - Symptoms of COVID-19
  - Positive SARS-CoV-2 viral test within the past 10 days
  - Close contact with someone with COVID-19 within the past 10 days
- The Department of Health continues to recommend increased hand hygiene as flu and other respiratory illnesses continue in King County.
- Increase ventilation as much as possible during visits.
- Well-fitting facemasks are required in licensed areas – Assisted Living, Memory Care, and Skilled Nursing & Rehab.
- Visitors should go directly to the visitors' room and directly out of the facility when the visit has ended.
- Maintaining 6 feet of physical distance when physical distancing is feasible.
