As of the writing of this memo on Thursday, October 5, 2023, we have a total of one (1) COVID positive case in the building. The following breakdown is as follows:

One (1) resident in Independent Living

As you may know, we have had some staff members who have tested positive or have had an exposure. In each case, we have followed our staff protocols to ensure health for all.

Because it is clear that COVID has been in our community, we encourage optional use of masks in public settings and lots of hand washing.

If you are not feeling well, please take care of yourself, consult your primary care physician if applicable, and stay home to avoid getting anyone else sick.

We encourage the use of rapid self-tests, also called at-home tests, as a quick and convenient way to screen for COVID-19 on your own. You may find rapid tests in stores, pharmacies and online.
