Our updated COVID cases in Bayview are as follows:

- 2 residents in Assisted Living which are expected to be off isolation in the next couple of days:
 - 1 resident on ALU 2nd floor (non-memory care).
 - 1 resident in Dorothy's Place
- 1 independent living resident

Communal activities and dining have resumed in Assisted Living as of today. We are encouraging residents to wear surgical masks throughout the outbreak status which is 14 days past our last reported positive COVID case in Assisted Living on Monday, August 26.

Bayview staff continue to wear masks throughout the building at this time.

- **Visitation is not restricted**; however, we are asking visitors to consider postponing visits until the outbreak is clear to help keep the viral load down. If you are visiting a resident who is COVID positive, please consider wearing the PPE provided outside of the residents' room.
- **All visitors need to wear a mask to visit assisted living, 2nd, 3rd or Dorothy's Place at this time.**

A few reminders:

- If you are not feeling well, please take care of yourself, consult your primary care physician if applicable, and stay home to avoid getting anyone else sick.
- We encourage the use of rapid self-tests, also called at-home tests, as a quick and convenient way to screen for COVID-19 on your own. You may find rapid tests in stores, pharmacies and online.
